#### CACDA Receives Grant from Lake Foundation

**Cazenovia, NY** – Cazenovia Area Community Development Association, Inc. (CACDA) recently received confirmation of a grant for an initiative at Lakeside Park. Cazenovia Lake Foundation (CLF) has donated funding to help cover the cost of materials and supplies for a two phase restoration project.

The first phase of the project begins on Wednesday, 22 March at 7:00 p.m. at the Cazenovia Public Library with a presentation on the importance of preserving the local watershed. Scott Ingmire from Madison County Planning Department will be the featured speaker. All area residents are invited to attend.

The project's second phase will involve preparation of the shoreline area, and subsequent installation of native plants utilizing local volunteers and professionals of all ages. Actual planting dates have yet to be determined. The Village of Cazenovia and graduate students from SUNY Environmental Science and Forestry's Landscape Architecture program are assisting with the project.
